If we use a teaching and learning cycle to build writing instruction targeted at high bands, then students will increase their writing achievement.	<p>Year 3 –Students will; create a range of texts using background knowledge and text features for familiar and unfamiliar audiences and demonstrate an understanding of grammar (and choose vocabulary appropriate to the purpose of writing).</p> <p>Year 5 - Student will; show an understanding of how images and detail can be used to extend ideas and create imaginative, informative and persuasive texts for different purposes and audiences, demonstrate understanding of grammar using a variety of sentence types.</p> <p>Year 7 –Students will; create structured and cohesive texts that elaborate on key ideas for a range of purposes and audiences. Students will use considered grammar and vocabulary choices to enhance and structure writing, and show how language features and images from other texts can be combined for effect.</p> <p>Year 9 –Student’s will create texts for learning area purposes, selecting language to influence audience response. The texts will respond to issues, interpreting and integrating ideas from other texts, and use vocabulary and grammar that contribute to the precision and persuasiveness of the writing piece.</p> <p>Stage 1 –Students will demonstrate analysis and evaluation of learning area texts and subject specific vocabulary. They will apply this to create texts appropriate to the purpose of the learning area.</p>

If we use a teaching and learning cycle to strengthen reading instruction targeted at high bands, then students will increase their writing achievement.	<p>Year 3 –Student’s will monitor meaning and self-correct using phonics, syntax, punctuation, semantics and context knowledge and identify literal and implied meaning connecting ideas in different parts of a text.</p> <p>Year 5 –Student’s will fluently read texts that include varied structures and unfamiliar vocabulary, including multisyllabic words and analyse and explain literal information from a variety of texts.</p> <p>Year 7 - Student’s will analyse and explain how language features, images and vocabulary are used to represent ideas, characters and events. Each student will demonstrate understanding of how choice of language features, images and vocabulary affects meaning and analyse supporting evidence and implied meaning.</p> <p>Year 9 – Student’s will interpret text, explain how language features, images and vocabulary are used to represent different ideas and issues, and select evidence from the text to show how events, situations and people can be represented from different viewpoints. Each student will evaluate and integrate ideas and information from texts to form their own interpretations and select evidence from texts to analyse and explain language choices used to influence an audience.</p> <p>Stage 1/2 – Student’s will demonstrate analysis and evaluation of learning area texts to create texts appropriate to the purpose of the learning area.</p>
